

Policy on Multi-Level Marketing/Direct Sales/Commercial Activities in the Church:

- The church is the house of God, a holy and spiritual place, not a venue for commercial activities. To prevent the church's operations and fellowship from being tainted by commercial interests, our church does not tolerate any individuals, including members of our church, conducting any form of multi-level marketing or commercial activities on church premises or during church fellowship/meetings/events. If such activities are observed, the congregation should refuse participation and notify the pastor or deacon for follow-up.
- Congregants should also refrain from disclosing others' personal information for commercial solicitation.

Biblical Principles:

Do Not Abuse Freedom:

- "All things are lawful," but not all things are helpful. "All things are lawful," but not all things build up. Let no one seek his own good, but the good of his neighbor. (1 Corinthians 10:23-24)

For the Glory of God:

- So, whether you eat or drink, or whatever you do, do all to the glory of God. (1 Corinthians 10:31)

Do Not Cause Others to Stumble:

- Give no offense to Jews or to Greeks or to the church of God, (1 Corinthians 10:32)

Seek Not Your Own Benefit:

- Just as I try to please everyone in everything I do, not seeking my own advantage, but that of many, that they may be saved. (1 Corinthians 10:33)

Preserve the Holiness of the Church:

- And Jesus entered the temple and drove out all who sold and bought in the temple, and he overturned the tables of the money-changers and the seats of those who sold pigeons. He said to them, "It is written, 'My house shall be called a house of prayer,' but you make it a den of robbers." (Matt 21:12-13)
- And he told those who sold the pigeons, "Take these things away; do not make my Father's house a house of trade." (John 2:16)
